Abyrx[™] Announces National Distribution Partnership with Unify Surgical to Support Growing Demand for Abyrx's Biosurgical Products in the United States' Cardiothoracic Surgery Marketplace

Under the terms of the agreement, Unify will have leadership responsibility for representing Abyrx's products in a regional territory and for aggregating additional cardiothoracic distributors throughout the United States. Abyrx and Unify will use the KairukuTM Platform to organize a variable commissioning structure for their affiliate distribution representatives and to track product utilization at the point-of-care to ensure accurate and timely reporting of sales and compensation.

Founded by cardiothoracic market veterans Harry McDonald and Jim Wood, Unify is the premier cardiothoracic-focused independent distribution agency with significant management experience and success in identifying, acquiring, and commercializing clinically relevant products in the cardiothoracic market. Abyrx will use the Kairuku Platform to seamlessly integrate Unify's representatives and their affiliate partners into Abyrx's existing distribution network, which currently comprises several hundred cardiothoracic, craniomaxillofacial, orthopaedic, and spine representatives. Abyrx will maintain responsibility for its own product training and payment of compensation owed to Unify and its affiliate partners.

Commenting on the announced partnership, Unify's Principals, Harry McDonald and Jim Wood, issued the following joint statement, "Abyrx has the most comprehensive product offering in the bone hemostasis marketplace and a very rich and exciting product pipeline. Using the Kairuku Platform, we are confident that Unify can help achieve the full market potential for Abyrx's products in cardiothoracic surgery. Kairuku is a game-changing technology that will enable us to aggregate cardiothoracic distributors throughout the United States and connect them to Abyrx and other manufacturers seeking to optimize their access to the point-of-care in ways otherwise not achievable."

Remarking on the significance of Abyrx's partnership with Unify Surgical, John J. Pacifico, Abyrx's President and Chief Executive Officer, stated, "Responsible product education and excellent delivery of service in the cardiothoracic surgery marketplace require extraordinary and professional leadership.
